Application for Admission

Essex North Shore Agricultural & Technical School admits students and makes available to them its advantages, privileges, and courses of study without regard to race, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, disability, religion, age, veteran status or homelessness. Essex North Shore Agricultural & Technical School has an approved Admissions Policy that outlines the admissions criteria and process. The completed "Application for Admission" should be submitted to the Essex North Shore Agricultural & Technical School Admissions Office no later than the second Friday of January for fall Grade 9 Admission* with records required from the applicant's current school. In addition to this completed and signed application form, the applicant's current guidance counselor will submit records of the criteria that will be used for admission: the applicant's grades (Term 1 and Term 2 or Trimester 1 grades of the current school year and all Terms/Trimester grades from the previous school year) and attendance and discipline/conduct records (through mid-year of the current school year and the entirety of previous school year). The applicant's current guidance counselor is also required to complete the Guidance Counselor Section and Recommendation on page 4 of this application. A fifth criterion consisting of an interview with the applicant will also be used to evaluate the student's application for admission. *Fall Grade 10-12 transfer application deadline is April 15.
