#### Enrollment:

New skills: Nail care and foot care. Field trip to the Public Health Museum in Tewskbury

11 Grade: Transferring & Positioning; Personal Care; Responding to Emergencies

New skills: Transferring, Positioning, Oral Care, BLS and First Aid



12 Grade: CNA preparation - new testing agency for MA (D&S Headmaster); Basic Finance/Budgeting; Medical Math

#### 11 Grade Theory: Anatomy & Physiology

- Disease based curriculum to develop working knowledge
- Will be doing heart dissections in November (pig hearts).

**Equipment:** Our new lab space is just about complete. We will be acquiring 3 new bed suites to maximize our learning space.
