- Beginning balance for 2021-22 school year: \$24,224.00
- Current balance (as of this morning): \$20,455.74

## 3. Old Business

- Class of Apparel shop- hoping for more of an update, but don't at the moment. Ended October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Reach out to get final numbers on what sold, owner unable to get to us by this meeting.
- May run again in spring after acceptance letters go out.
- Heather- May consider looking into another company before next apparel fundraiser.
   This needs to be a fundraiser that a company can set up an online store.

#### 4. New Business

- Concession stand- years past, PTO has only run concession stand for Homecoming. This year, Mike Murphy the new Athletic Director, reached out to all the clubs to see if they would be interested in running the stand- they all declined. So he reached out to the PTO a few days before the 1<sup>st</sup> game with just a few days noticed. Mike just reached out again on Monday- he is unable to get any of the home games covered and would the PTO like to do all the home games? Don't want to say no- but it is a lot of work.
  - PTO uses Sign up Genius: donations, volunteer shifts
  - Set up starts at around 4 for a 6pm game. Unloaded and into the concession, organized and set up, coffee and popcorn made.
  - Table outside of concession stand- where PTO sells merchandise, "information center" for parents.
